A seal-pendant in gold, enamel, rubies, pearls, and hardstones. Early 19th century. This charming seal-pendant depicts a Moor's bust, the head sculpted in carnelian and the hair rendered in chalcedony agate. The body, in finely chased gold and enameled in black, is adorned with spirals punctuated by small pearls and rubies. The top is crowned with an elegant openwork gold motif serving as a suspension ring. The base, also decorated with rubies and small pearls, contains an engraved agate seal representing a warrior's head. A precious object of fine workmanship, typical of the refined taste of the early decades of the 19th century. Height: 3.9 cm. Gross weight: 12 g.
