Beautiful patina of use, shiny in places (repeated handling). Height 25cm x 44cm long x 15cm wide max. Spectacular two-headed dog in hardwood with traces of polychromy and magical charge on its back. These sculptures, anthropomorphic or zoomorphic, have long been classified in the category of vengeful spirits, but their function is much more ambivalent. It is when the Nganga completes the sculptor's work by driving the nails into the Nkonde that the latter acquires its magical power. Its action is not secret; on the contrary, its mission is public.
