### Description

Elegant oil painting on canvas, housed in a carved wooden frame gilded with pure gold. The painting depicts the portrait of a woman, based on the work by Sebastiano del Piombo, now in the Uffizi Gallery, and dated 1512. The woman is depicted standing, with her face in three-quarter view and her intense gaze directed toward the viewer. The great attention to detail is evident, such as the fur she wears, the small rings, and the rich fabrics of her dress. This is a painting of great taste and refinement, capable of lending a touch of antiquity to any setting. Finally, the painting features a plaque on the back of its author, Dario Angeloni, a famous Florentine painter active in the mid-19th century.
