The fluidity of the lines and the absence of right angles are emblematic of this period. Material: Made of solid wood, with a beautiful natural patina. The wood is richly carved with rocaille motifs and shells on

the stiles and the lower rail, harmoniously framing the drawers. These motifs are the quintessence of Rococo ornamentation. Openings: It opens with three large drawers in three rows. Ornamentation: It is adorned with magnificent chased and gilded bronze fittings: pull handles and key escutcheons (requiring restoration/regilding) with highly elaborate Rocaille decor, typical of the Louis XV period and the Rococo movement.
