Louis-Robert CARRIER-BELLEUSE (1848-1913) for the Choisy-le-Roi Manufacture. Pair of fine earthenware baluster vases - circa 1890. An elegant pair of fine earthenware baluster vases with rich polychrome and relief decoration. Against a luminous beige-blue background unfold allegorical compositions of draped female figures surrounded by putti, floral garlands, and delicately modelled scrolls. The subtle palette - cream, celadon blue, and soft green - blends in perfect harmony, highlighting the virtuosity of the modelling and the graceful rhythm of the figures. Each vase displays refined ornamentation: friezes of palmettes, floral garlands in light relief, and stylized mascarons. The ensemble perfectly exemplifies the neoclassical taste and the
