Large Gothic Architectural Elements - Authentic Wooden Church Fragments, 19th Century. These exceptional, large-scale Gothic elements likely date from the 19th century and were originally used as decorative infill within a religious building. The characteristic quatrefoil and cross motifs, combined with the deeply carved X-shaped structure, clearly demonstrate the Neo-Gothic style, which experienced a resurgence in popularity in Europe from the mid-19th century. Crafted from solid wood and hand-carved, these elements possess impressive depth and patina: the marks of time, abrasion, slight irregularities, and the warm, golden-brown surface combine to create the authenticity sought after by collectors and interior designers today. Their size makes these elements suitable not only
