Glass vase. Signed underneath: Jean-Claude Novaro, master glassmaker born in Antibes (1943-2014). This vase has a slender shape, with a flared base and a narrow neck. Its surface is marked by pink and white hues. The overall impression is one of lightness and fluidity, typical of pieces made using traditional glassmaking techniques. It can serve as both a decorative element and a collector's item. Jean Claude Novaro, active primarily from the 1970s onward, mainly used the glassblowing technique, which allowed him to achieve slender forms, fluid silhouettes, and colorful internal patterns.
