Large Italian majolica centerpiece in the Neo-Rococo style, depicting three putti supporting a wide, shell-shaped basin resting on a triple, undulating shell adorned with stylized polychrome foliage. The naturalistic decoration and polychromy are typical of late 19th-century Italian decorative arts, in the tradition of the Capodimonte or Bassano workshops.

Thick-glazed majolica with polychrome decoration. Finely modeled faces. Highly sculptural base. A striking presence and a generously sized piece. Wear to the edges, a stable crack, and glaze crazing typical of antique Italian majolica. Italy, end 19th - Beg 20th century
