Description

A substantial and large Regency period armchair with a cane back, made of natural waxed and patinated wood, circa 1720. This large seat, with its highly unusual proportions (see photo 2 / comparison with a chair of the same period), was originally a commode chair. Superbly molded and finely carved, the armchair features a cane-backed seat. The seat consists of a fixed structure upon which rests a removable, lined, and beige velvet-covered top. Given the chair's atypical and exceptional dimensions and proportions, it was most likely a custom order, making this armchair a truly exceptional piece of furniture. A side opening on one side of the seat allows the armchair to be used as a storage bench. The rear legs are steeply angled, providing excellent stability. The upholstery of the
