Description

- Gété brand pocket watch accompanied by its warranty certificate and its proof test on tracing paper in solid silver decorated with scrolls and vertical straight lines and a blank escutcheon without initials. - Gété SA watch and chronometer manufacturer, founded in 1887, successor to the Grisot & Troncin brothers watch factory located at 4 Place du Jura, currently Place de Lattre de Tassigny in Besançon, Doubs department (25). - French hallmark of 800/1000 fineness expressed in thousandths, used in France from 1834 to 1984, present on the case back, dust cover and on the edge of the watch case with the mint mark of the Besançon precious metals control office between the crab's lower legs, number 54772 engraved in relief on the case back and dust cover. - Gété brand logo hallmark

engraved in relief on the case back. - Goldsmith's hallmark in a diamond shape on the dust cover and the letters L&F with a lizard between the two letters for the Lévy Frères company, watch case manufacturer. - The Lévy Frères company is located at 25 rue Gambetta in Besançon. Smooth edge of the watch and bezel, silvered crown winder and slightly domed beveled mineral crystal. - White enamel dial marked Gété in full and the brand's logo painted in black at 12 o'clock. Arabic numerals for the hours and 24-hour markers painted in black, railway track minute markers. - Small seconds subdial at six o'clock, Arabic numerals for the seconds, railway track minute markers painted in black and blued steel seconds hand. - Gilt brass movement signed "Gété chronometer" in full and engraved in relief on the ruby-jeweled movement with escapement, blued steel screws, crown wheel, ratchet wheel, and polished steel advance/retard regulator located above the balance wheel. - Winding via pendant and time setting by pulling on the top of the winding crown and simultaneously turning the crown clockwise. In perfect working order, serviced by a watchmaker. - Early 20th century, circa 1900-1918. Gross weight: 81,90 gr.-

Reminder to buyers regarding the right of withdrawal for online sales via my Proantic store.- Must be read before purchasing from my sales site hosted by Proantic.- The right of withdrawal applies to sales made through my Proantic store.- The withdrawal period is 14 days following the buyer's receipt of the item or goods.- The buyer must notify me via email or registered letter--without needing to provide a reason or justification--within the 14-day statutory period following receipt of the parcel or item.- The buyer has the right to change their mind and benefits from the 14-day statutory cooling-off period; I respect this right.- Once this period has elapsed, the sale will be considered final and binding.- Return shipping costs (via postal service or carrier) are the buyer's responsibility in the event of withdrawal.- The

buyer is required to return the item or goods within 14 days of receipt, in the same condition as received (free from breakage or damage) and in the original packaging. The return must use a shipping method with insurance coverage equal to the sale price on my Proantic site (matching the level of insurance originally arranged by the seller). The buyer must also email me the proof of posting/drop-off receipt issued by the postal service or the shipping slip issued by the carrier. - All sales made via my Proantic site are covered by insurance purchased from La Poste at the time of shipping; this covers loss or theft up to the purchase price paid by the buyer.- La Poste does not provide insurance against breakage or damage to the item or object; coverage for parcel transport is limited to theft and loss.- Additional insurance covering breakage or damage--up to the price paid by the buyer on my Proantic site--is always purchased from the carrier when a third-party carrier is used.- The buyer risks legal penalties if they fail to return the item or object within the 14-day period and in good condition.- Refunds for the item or object will be issued within 14 days of the seller receiving the item or parcel and verifying its condition.- If the item or object is found not to match its original condition at the time of dispatch, the sale will be considered final and non-refundable; the right of withdrawal will not apply.- Refunds for the item or object will be issued using the same payment method (check, bank transfer, PayPal) used by the buyer for the original purchase on my Proantic site.- If payment was made via PayPal, the buyer is responsible for initiating the refund process--specifically, by navigating to the "Dispute" section and opening a dispute case involving themselves, PayPal, and the seller.- This notice regarding sales on my Proantic site is addressed to individuals prone to litigation or acting in bad faith. - I advise anyone prone to litigation or acting in bad faith not to purchase anything from my Proantic shop; this will save me from wasting time and money on legal

proceedings.- Fortunately, my sales on Proantic generally go very smoothly, as the customers are usually pleasant, agreeable, and acting in good faith.- Best regards,- Mr. Pineaud.
