Jacob Mardochée, known as Jacob Petit, born and died in Paris (1796-1868), was a 19th-century French porcelain manufacturer. His name remains associated with the originality of his work. Abundant and diverse, once considered excessively tasteless, his pieces are now sought after for their originality, the quality of their finish, and the richness of their polychromy. This rare piece is in good condition. A true collector's item.
