This is an important terracotta depicting a little girl playing with her dog, signed Alph Van Beurden for Alphonse Van Beurden, and dated 1880. The details are charming and beautifully executed; look at the dog's fur, its playful attitude, and the child's smile! Alphonse Van Beurden was a Belgian painter and sculptor, born in 1854 and died in 1938. His works can be found in Belgium and France. He demonstrated astonishing dexterity in rendering life and movement through his sculptures and a remarkable ability to play with natural childlike poses or contrast with fantastical characters. I have already presented a superb life-size faun's head on Proantic, which

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appeared as an old man. The long beard and pointed ears give it a slightly mysterious air! Excellent condition, but one of the little girl's feet was reattached a long time ago; it's almost invisible. A superb waxed terracotta patina.
