Description

Origin and attribution

This glazed white-porcelain figure was produced by Bing & Grøndahl in Copenhagen. The underside bears the typical green three-towers mark together with B&G Denmark and the impressed number 29, identifying the sculpture as the "Mother and Child" (Model 29) created by Danish sculptor Svend Lindhart.

The style of the mark places its production between 1952 and 1958.

Description and subject

The figurine depicts a reclining young mother breastfeeding her child. The modelling is soft, rounded and deliberately simplified, reflecting the Scandinavian modernist aesthetic of the mid-20th century.

The pure white glaze emphasizes the sculptural

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volumes and the gentle emotional tone of the maternal theme.

Materials and technique

- High-quality Danish hard-paste porcelain
- Rounded, organic modelling characteristic of Svend Lindhart
- Clear glossy glaze, evenly applied
- Impressed model number (29) and printed B&G mark under the base

Artistic context

Svend Lindhart (1898-1988) created numerous figures for Bing & Grøndahl, focusing on human themes rendered with simplicity, subtle movement and emotional clarity. Model 29 is among the most appreciated examples of his work for the manufactory, valued for its sensitive depiction of motherhood.

Condition report

The figurine is in very good condition, with no chips, cracks or visible repairs. The glaze is intact and bright, and all sculptural details remain crisp. The underside mark is clean and fully legible.
