A bronze clock decorated in the Louis XVI Rococo style, featuring foliage, caryatids, and a putto. The dial is marked with black enamel Roman numerals on a white background, with the inscription "Comptoir général, Boulevard de la Poissonnière Paris." It includes a key and pendulum. The Japy mechanism strikes the hours and half-hours; its operation requires servicing. Regarding the clock: the mention in the instruction manual of "working" or "the movement engages" is indicative only and does not guarantee that servicing is necessary. The movements have not been tested for long-term reliability. Period: late 19th/early 20th century. Dimensions: 37 x 25 x 15 cm; weight approximately 4 kg. Good condition.
