A Wedgwood plaque mounted as a brooch on silver. The decoration depicts two goddesses of war, likely Athena and Minerva, alongside cherubs. There is a striking contrast in the white bas-relief against a blue background, typical of Wedgwood. Good condition. Dimensions : Diameter: 5 cm. Wedgwood was a British pottery, earthenware, and porcelain factory founded in May 1759, at the very beginning of the Industrial Revolution in the United Kingdom, by Josiah Wedgwood and his son Thomas Wedgwood.
