Painting/lithograph "Three Nudes" by Camille Hilaire, numbered artist's proof, 1940s. Camille Hilaire (1916-2004) -- Nude, lithograph, 1940s. A painter and engraver from Lorraine, trained in Paris and closely associated with the teachings of André Lhote, Camille Hilaire developed a lyrical and structured style from the 1940s onward: faceted planes, supple lines, luminous colors. His major themes--nudes, bathers, landscapes--blend classical elegance and modernity. This beautiful lithograph on paper depicts a stylized female nude, with simplified volumes and fluid lines. A balance between flat areas and transparencies, and a soft palette (typical of the 1940s) highlight the silhouette. Numbered and signed artist's proof, simply framed and ready to hang. A decorative and refined work, typical of Hilaire's
