A chrysanthemum-shaped dish, decorated in the Famille Verte style. The center is decorated with glossy enamels depicting a vase of blooming chrysanthemums on a building's terrace. Inside, a frieze of vases and precious objects, evoking cracked glass, alternates with bamboo and pine medallions. The rim is decorated with plum blossoms. The underside features floral sprays.
