This object, described in cultural heritage catalogues, is composed of three small circular basins and a larger central one, supported by allegorical anthropomorphic figures. The city of Laterza is remembered for its famous majolica with its elegant chromatic application. Laterza majolica typically uses few elements and few colors, with blue and yellow predominating on a white background. Dimensions: height 13 cm, width 14 cm, depth 14 cm
