"Desert Bar" square rug, designed by Jean-Charles de Castelbajac in 1985, woven in tufted wool. At its center, four feline creatures lean towards a blue oasis, as if captured in a suspended moment. Their slender bodies radiate outwards, their tails escaping the frame, giving the impression that the scene spills into the real world. The surface is tinged with a solar orange, punctuated by black shadows, bursts of yellow, and the depth of a nocturnal blue. A dark border highlights the composition, while the artist's signature is discreetly woven into the weave.
