An elegant Napoleon III games table (circa 1860-1880) veneered in rosewood and palisander, adorned with stringing and charming floral marquetry at the four corners. The fluted legs terminate in small bronze feet. It slides open to reveal a large green felted top bordered by a gilt Greek key pattern, ideal for cards. The lower section contains a complete backgammon board in its original condition, with its original geometric design and a few tokens. The upper top, inlaid with a herringbone pattern, shows slight signs of wear (visible in the photo) which do not detract from its overall aesthetic.
