Description

I'm stumped on the name of this Gothic structure, often seen used to house a Christ figure, the Arma Christi of the Passion, or even sometimes the bust of a king... Anyway, this piece of folk art has been identified by AI: The image shows a miniature Calvary. It's a piece of folk art or craft, probably a work of domestic devotion. The scene depicts the crucifixion of Jesus Christ on the cross, with the inscription INRI (Jesus Nazareus Rex Iudaeorum, meaning "Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews") visible above his head. The architectural structure is elaborate, with twisted columns and decorative elements, all contained under a glass dome, which is typical of antique religious collectibles or memorabilia. The style and materials suggest it could be an old piece, perhaps from the 19th or early 20th century.
