Pair of Tempo model armchairs by Joseph-André Motte (1925-2013), produced in the 1960s by the Steiner company. They have not been reissued. One of the most important French designers of the post-war period, he was a leading figure of modernism in both design and interior architecture. His work was characterized by exacting standards, a sense of proportion, and a need to harmonize beauty with utility. He designed numerous chairs for Steiner, each a volume with rounded or orthogonal forms that seem suspended in space, so delicate are their legs.
