Oil on panel signed by Georges Binet, a painter trained at the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris in Bonnat's studio and renowned for his plein air scenes and works captured from life. Faithful to his Post-Impressionist style, Binet here deploys a vibrant touch, generous impasto, and a luminous palette to capture a typical moment of the Belle Époque: a gentleman wearing a white cap, a very fashionable accessory in nautical and social circles, and a woman in a wide-brimmed hat, brought together in a refined and intimate atmosphere. The artist, who exhibited regularly at the Parisian Salons from the 1890s onward, excelled in these quick and sensitive scenes
