It is accompanied by two crossed tibiae, also in ivory, and a frontal plaque engraved with "Memento Mori." This Spanish work from the late 19th century is of exceptional craftsmanship. Description: The skull exhibits highly realistic modeling: deep eye sockets, meticulously crafted teeth, internal texture of the nose, and fissures imitating cranial sutures. The surface displays a beautiful antique patina, with a natural network of cracks characteristic of antique ivory. The long bones are carved in the same material, with visible grain and smoothed ends. The entire piece rests on a velvet-covered wooden base, slightly
