The lower part of the hat is adorned with a hemispherical brass uniform button stamped with the Second Empire eagle surrounded by laurel branches, with an upper band inscribed "Ponts et Chaussées" (Bridges and Roads). The interior lining consists of a tobacco-colored calfskin band and an ivory silk lining. Good overall condition, hat shows signs of wear. Size 55 cm.
