At the center is a pedestal adorned with floral garlands, upon which stand five dancing cherubs, one of which is taller in the center. This tasteful and exquisitely crafted centerpiece adds a touch of class and sophistication to any setting. The workshop's initials are also engraved on the bottom of the centerpiece. Viennese manufacture, first half of the 19th century.
