An important Napoleon III period mantel clock in gilt bronze and polychrome porcelain in shades of pink and blue. The dial, with enameled Roman numerals, is centered on a porcelain plaque decorated with a floral wreath and surmounted by an oval containing the portrait of a young woman of high rank, possibly representing the Countess du Barry. On either side is a detached column in floral porcelain and bronze, and at the rear, covered pots in the same materials. Below the dial, a porcelain plaque depicts a reclining cherub holding a lyre. This beautiful clock is in very good condition and works perfectly: it has been professionally serviced. The dial has no glass.
