This elegant display cabinet perfectly embodies the refined and organic spirit of Art Nouveau. Made in 1900 from solid mahogany, a noble wood prized for its warm hue and durability, it is distinguished by its slender and airy silhouette, supported by four tapered legs connected by curved stretchers with vegetal accents. The upper structure, entirely glazed, offers ideal transparency for displaying precious objects, porcelain, or curiosities. The carved wooden frame features soft, asymmetrical lines, typical of the naturalist aesthetic of the period. The glass door, mounted on discreet hinges, is fitted with a small patinated metal latch, adding a touch of functional delicacy. The gentle curves make this display cabinet a work of art, a testament to a time when the domestic object became
