Description

Elegant Woman in a Hat in a Boat, 1936, annotated "on the water." A young city woman sits in a boat, gliding on calm water. Seen in profile, wearing a large, light-colored hat, she is dressed in a simple and elegant outfit. Her face is finely drawn, the volumes of her body simplified, and the banks and the water reduced to flat planes and stylized curves. The whole creates a poetic atmosphere, very typical of the interwar period, somewhere between fashion illustration and a leisure scene. Signed in the lower right corner, along with the annotation "on the water," which establish the date and subject of the painting. The signature is yet to be identified, but the highly graphic style clearly evokes the world of illustrators of the 1930s. This sheet belongs to the decorative and illustrative movement of the

1930s, halfway between fashion illustration and poetic poster art. Through its subject - a young city woman with a hat, a boat, a stylized body of water - and through its refined design with synthesized volumes, it recalls the aesthetics of artists like Louis Fortuney, a great specialist in pastel and illustration projects, or, in the world of fashion and posters, George Barbier, Georges Lepape, Christian Bérard, René Bouët-Willaumez, but also the graphic spirit of Art Deco poster artists such as Cassandre or Roger Broders. It can thus be presented as a work of French school from the interwar period, in the Art Deco style / fashion illustration of the 1930s.
