Description

A very elegant Louis XV period flat desk, crafted from violet wood with fine marquetry in a frieze pattern. It features three drawers in the frieze (three simulated drawers on the back), including a recessed central drawer. It rests on four cabriole legs richly adorned with delicately carved and openwork acanthus leaf motifs, which connect the feet with a fine giltwood band. The gilt bronze mounts are exquisitely chased, with delicately crafted keyhole escutcheons and contours. The top is covered in gilt leather tooled in small gilts, framed by a gilt bronze molding that accentuates the piece's supple and harmonious lines. A Parisian work from the mid-18th century, bearing the stamp of master cabinetmaker Pierre Migeon (Migeon II), one of the most renowned craftsmen of the reign of Louis XV, known for his elegant
