Description

Jean-Marie Rollion (1846-1929): "Still Life with Helmet," oil on canvas, 61 x 50 cm, mounted in a large black frame with a gilt molding, 89 x 78 cm (minor damages). Two small patches on the back. The artist, a still-life painter, was a member of the Salon des Artistes Français, where this work may have been exhibited, judging by the fragment of a label in the lower left corner. A student of Gérôme, he also studied with his brother-in-law, Ferdinand Roybet, a specialist in 17th-century-style portraits, in whose studio these accessories were probably painted. The crested helmet, powder flask, and sword with a "tazza" (a
