The delicately curved metal stand supports the sphere and emphasizes its decorative character. This miniature globe testifies to the expertise of the Abel-Klinger workshop, famous for the quality of its printing and for its small globes intended for cabinets of curiosities, schools, and geography enthusiasts.
