A superb bronze sculptural group by François Vandenberghe (born in 1951), depicting a family of three elephants on the move. Cast in bronze using the lost-wax technique and featuring a magnificent "African earth" patina, this piece testifies to the sculptor's exceptional skill in rendering volume, texture, and movement. The group, with its striking presence (approximately 30 cm high by 50 cm long), is a limited edition, numbered 6/8, bearing the artist's signature "Vandenberghe" and the FBL foundry mark ("FBL lost-wax bronze"), guaranteeing meticulous production faithful to the original edition's specifications. Vandenberghe, whose bestiary is marked by his extended stay in Central Africa, is renowned for the emotional power of his compositions and his ability to capture the
