



Necklace, Pearls, Gold And Silver, 19th Century.

Description

This exquisite, delicate, and feminine necklace consists of five strands of small pearls linked by gold bars. These bars hold three chains of gemstones attached to a central daisy motif.

Below this daisy hangs a round teardrop, set with white spinels. The cylindrical gold clasp is a ratchet clasp, enameled with small flowers and geometric patterns, and bears the eagle's head hallmark, in use since 1838. The bars also bear the provincial hallmark, a horse's head, used from 1839 to 1919. 19th century. Length 37.5 cm
