Dimensions: 3.90 $m \times 2.75$ m. This rug features a rich and elegant composition typical of the Napoleon III style, with a particularly refined floral design. The design is organized around a large central medallion composed of a lush bouquet of roses and swirling flowers, rendered with finesse and lightness. The contours of the central motif are emphasized by a succession of symmetrically arranged scrolls and arabesques, creating a harmonious and majestic frame. The multifaceted border, punctuated by decorative panels and four

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corner medallions adorned with bouquets, structures the whole with great fluidity. The floral motifs repeat in garlands and wreaths, giving the rug an impression of continuous movement. The subtle color variations--those characteristic gradients of handwoven rugs--are visible in shades of pink, cream, and terracotta, adding depth and softness to the design. The colors transition delicately from light to dark, particularly in the ochre leaves, petals, and scrolls, creating the effect of subtle, natural blends. The overall effect is a refined, romantic, and warm atmosphere, true to the grand decorative pieces of the 19th century inspired by historical settings.
