Everyday objects, their refinement has always amazed me... Woven and embroidered wool on wool using traditional methods. The extremely fine weave makes the piece supple and lightweight. The plant-based colors are remarkably fresh; they have survived a century and a half without losing their vibrancy and brilliance. Beautifully harmonious, circa 1880. Perfect condition!
