Description

An interesting oil on canvas, French school, 19th century, depicting a lively scene in a Breton village. The painting is of very high quality in terms of execution and detail. We can attribute this painting to the artist Louis Caradec, born on July 28, 1802, in Brest, and died in the same city on April 29, 1888. He painted numerous Breton landscapes and interior scenes, but especially many portraits in traditional Breton costumes, as well as scenes of daily life, markets, and festivals. His works exhibit a high level of execution and precision in the reproduction of costumes and accessories.

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
