The drop-front with a green leather opens to reveal a meticulously fitted interior, complemented by a lower door. The keyholes, escutcheons, apron, and finials--crafted in chased and gilded bronze--add a refined touch. The white Carrara marble top, framed by an openwork gallery, completes this exceptional piece.
