Philibert Benoit Delarue (1718-1780) was a draftsman, painter, and engraver, often working on historical subjects. The drawing sheet is in very good condition and measures 21.5 cm x 13.5 cm. It is housed in a 20th-century giltwood frame, with some losses and retouching of the gilding.
