This circular base, resting on two cleats, was once used to store a small barrel. The inscription is likely the owner's name, "Nakamura Yoshiyaki" (?). Its worn appearance gives it a wabi-sabi aesthetic. It could be used to display a bonsai tree, or perhaps a terracotta or plaster sculpture. Dense wood. Weight: 2.6 kg
