Khorasan rug, northeastern Iran, wool, wool warp and weft, circa 1970-80. Very good condition. The knots have been restored in our workshop. During their migrations, Turkmen tribes settled all along the border region in Khorasan. These migrations likely date back to the 16th century. These are authentic and inviting rugs that perpetuate ancient Turkmen, Ersari, and other motifs. The rug's field consists of three prominent medallions surrounded by a multitude of eight-pointed Median stars set within octagons representing the universe.
