## Description

A superb 19th-century oil painting on canvas, depicting an elegant and faithful reproduction of Hans Memling's (1430-1494) famous motif: The Virgin Between Two Musical Angels. This work belongs to the great historicist movement of the 19th century, which saw a revival of interest in the Flemish Primitives, particularly in Belgium, France, and Germany, at a time when museums were enriching their collections with 15th-century masterpieces. The scene, very similar to Memling's compositions, presents: The Virgin, depicted in a bust-length portrait, wearing a flowing red cloak, seated before a Gothic architectural setting. The Christ Child, portrayed with tenderness, in the Flemish tradition. Two musical angels on either side, balancing the scene: one playing a stringed instrument, the

other a wind instrument or a vielle, depending on the version by Memling.In the background: Gothic arcades, columns, a distant landscape, and a gradient sky, all characteristic of Bruges workshops. The composition reflects the contemplative spirit, graphic finesse, and perfect symmetry typical of the Bruges master. Graphic details and pictorial quality: A rich and nuanced palette, dominated by deep reds highlighted with gold. Subtle modeling of flesh tones, very typical of learned 19th-century copies. Great attention paid to the folds of the cloak, the capitals, the checkerboard pavement, and the landscape.A faithful rendering of the Memling style, without excess or over-interpretation. This is clearly a work executed by an artist trained in the academic tradition, perfectly mastering the graphic language of the 15th-century Flemish masters.FramePresented in an imposing 19th-century frame of molded and sculpted stucco, imitating antique wood, highly ornamental and decorated with openwork, scrolls, and Baroque foliage.
