The drapery is skillfully executed, and the contrasting veins of this marble accentuate the charming face of this young woman. The face is exquisitely delicate, the hair styled in a chignon from which strands escape, falling over the shoulders. A rose placed in the hair embellishes the whole. The fine sculpting of this face in white marble is quite remarkable, and one senses that the sculptor was inspired by the beautiful women
