## Description

Alain Pondeville, born in 1951, is a French painter whose work is distinguished by a vibrant palette and a joyfully stylized approach to scenes of everyday life. His pictorial world, marked by bold colors and simplified forms, reflects a search for spontaneity and harmony. Pondeville often draws inspiration from folk traditions, dances, villages, and scenes of daily life, which he reinterprets with modern energy and a strong sense of the decorative. The painting presented here, an oil on canvas in 2F format (19 x 24 cm), perfectly illustrates his style: a circle of figures in motion, houses with brightly colored roofs, and a landscape rendered in flat areas of color,
