Presented in a lovely gilt bamboo-style frame with bright gold leaf and nestled in a generous, deep, beveled mat, this curious colored wash drawing, "View taken in Languedoc on the banks of the Garonne," is a decorative piece worthy of a "Cabinet of Curiosities." The scene depicts a group of picturesque houses with doors and staircases in a bend of the "Little Garonne" at its source, where figures and animals--dog, goat, woman, child, and man--move about in an idyllic landscape. The beautiful inscription in Gothic script and the work's somewhat Chinese-inspired style, with its stylized and gentle naiveté, soft tones, and confident lines, make this charming painting a unique and highly decorative work.
