Description

Jean CABOI (1935), Landscape, Oil on canvas, 16 x 22 cm + frame (29 x 35 cm), signed lower right. Condition: very good. Jean Caboi, born in 1935, is a French painter known for his vibrant landscapes and his generous impasto technique, applied with a palette knife. His work is distinguished by a dense, almost sculpted texture and a luminous palette that highlights the countryside, villages, and scenes of the South of France. Caboi composes canvases where color and texture play an essential role: each thick brushstroke creates relief, life, and a warm atmosphere. The painting presented here, an oil on canvas measuring 16 x 22 cm, is a fine example. It depicts a house with red roofs, bathed in light, surrounded by abundant vegetation and yellow flowers rendered in expressive impasto.
