The bookcase is constructed in separate elements - including the molded cornice, top, lower section, and plinth - allowing it to be taken apart for easier access through properties where space or access may be restricted. The solid mahogany has developed a rich, warm patina, further enhancing its visual appeal and attesting to its superb original condition and careful stewardship over the years. William IV pedestal bookcases are celebrated for their imposing yet elegant design, often using
