Description

JohannaObermüller (*1938 Timisoara), Intertwined Figures, around 1985. Pigment printon Japanese paper, 25 cm x 33.5 cm (image), 29.8 cm x 42.5 cm (sheetdimensions), signed "Johanna Obermüller" in pencil lower right. -Complementary tension -Green andred figures are connected in a grotesque, symmetrical way. They are sointertwined that the figures form a single figuration, with the complementarycontrast of the colors increasing the inner tension. Only upon closerinspection does it become clear that these are the same figuration of a red anda green figure, which is sometimes overlaid and cropped by the greenbackground. The multiple figuration begins to dance, fragment, and reconfigureitself. A formal game that is at the same time an allegory
