### Description

Dutch School, 19th century. The Mill by the Water. Oil on canvas. Period giltwood frame. With frame: 51 x 42.5 cm. Without frame: 32 x 24 cm. This painting depicts an old watermill on the bank of a rushing stream, under a dramatic, cloud-laden sky. The light, filtered through the heavy clouds, illuminates the building, the movement of the water, and the surrounding vegetation. The composition highlights the traditional mill, recognizable by its partially submerged wheel, set within a typical Dutch rural landscape: massive trees, misty hills in the background, and a path along the riverbank. Small human figures stand out in front of the building, reinforcing the lively character of the scene. The harmonious palette--browns, ochres, deep greens, and bluish grays--recalls the warm,

nuanced tones of the Dutch school, while the treatment of the water and sky demonstrates a certain skill in rendering atmospheric effects.
