


Raffaele Giannetti (1858-1941) - Male Portrait, 1916 - Oil On Canvas

Raffaele Giannetti (Genoa, 1858 - 1941), Ligurian painter active between the 19th and 20th centuries, known for his portraits and genre scenes, distinguished by fine naturalistic detail and strong psychological presence. Description of the artwork: Elegant male portrait painted in 1916, executed in oil on canvas. The sitter, a refined young man, is depicted with a soft brushstroke and restrained palette characteristic of early 20th-century bourgeois portraiture.
